General Insurance Essentials (GIE)

This program is recommended for newcomers to the industry who have not yet made a definite career commitment. It is also for those employed in insurer, agency, broker or adjuster offices in junior or support positions who want an overview of the insurance industry but with some detail about actual coverage's and related claims routines. The GIE should also be considered by those who have been away from the education process for some time and are looking for an entry-level program to start their insurance education. It is also for those in the industry who have decided they would like to become licensed.

Successful graduates of the program will also be eligible to apply to the Insurance Institute of Canada to receive one credit (equivalent to C11 – Principles and Practice of Insurance) towards their CIP (Chartered Insurance Professional) designation, should they decide to continue their studies.

Course Content:

- basic documents, common clauses, insurance practices
- automobile insurance
- the law and insurance
- insurance contracts
- government control; insurance organizations and associations
- fire insurance; the Homeowner's policy
- other personal lines policies
- liability insurance
- commercial coverages: property, business interruption, crime, surety
- reinsurance
- risk management
- loss adjustment & prevention
